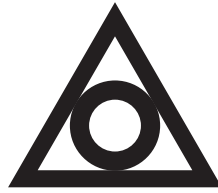

THE 2026 CSCO ANNUAL MEETING (INCLUDING 5 ORAL PRESENTATIONS)
